ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for Skilled Swingbed Services, these conditions must be met:

- Must have an order from the Medical Provider.
- Must have 3 consecutive midnights in acute care.
- Services must begin within 30 days of acute stay.
- Care needs must warrant skilled care based on a needs assessment by the care plan team.
